What does this course entail?

This workshop is designed to give people an opportunity to network and share experiences of fundraising. Within the voluntary and community sector, fundraising skills are essential to meet the demands of a changing economy and to help organisations diversify their sources of income. This is a one-day session.

It will allow opportunities for developing contacts and ideas that are important in charities, social enterprises and voluntary and community organisations. No formal qualifications are necessary.

What does the course cover?

The workshop enables learners to both network and learn more about the different ways to fundraise by exploring different types of fundraising and creating and exchanging ideas.

How is the course assessed?

No formal assessment. Group discussions and various activities / exercises. On completion an in-house certificate of attendance and participation will be issued.
